PROTECTION AGAINST SEXUAL EXPLOITATION AND ABUSE (PSEA)

EACH YEAR, THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE ARE BENEFICIARIES OF HUMANITARIAN AID, WHICH IS A RIGHT AND MUST NEVER BE EXCHANGED FOR SEXUAL FAVORS OR ANY OTHER SERVICE. TOGETHER, LET'S FIGHT AGAINST SEXUAL EXPLOITATION AND ABUSE.



HELP IS ALWAYS FREE

All assistance provided by humanitarian organizations is based on need and is free for everyone, including women, men, girls, boys, the elderly, and people with disabilities.



SEXUAL RELATIONSHIPS ARE PROHIBITED

Sexual relations between humanitarian workers and aid recipients are prohibited.

Sex with children or anyone under the age of 18 is strictly prohibited, **regardless** of the age of consent locally. Lack of knowledge of a child's actual age is not a defense.

It is strictly forbidden to ask for sexual favors or any other form of demeaning or degrading behavior in exchange for money, employment, goods or services, including any assistance to beneficiaries.
